

Huntingdon County Junior Livestock Market Steer Tag Day



When: Saturday, November 15, 2025 8 a.m. – 11 a.m.

Where: Huntingdon County Fairgrounds, Longhorn Corral

Who: Both Type and Carcass Steers*

General Information:

- Type Steers will show on **Tuesday Aug 11th, 2026 at 3pm!!**
- Steers must be **100% beef breeds** – commercial or purebred
- Steers must be naturally polled or dehorned before tag day
- Cattle are required to be castrated before tag day
- Be prepared to have your steer put in a chute for tagging and optional vaccination and deworming
- Each member may tag two (2) steers – only one (1) steer may be exhibited per member
- Exhibitors may show their steer in both Type and Carcass classes
- Animals in the same housing group may be shared between members.
- Both type and carcass steers must be halter broke for show
- Both type and carcass steers will be shown in Showmanship and may participate in the Obstacle Course
- All beef animals must have a state ID to be shown at the HCF – Steers will be tagged with 840 RFID Tags as HCF Tags for the 2026 Fair if they do not present with their own 840 tag. If they do have an 840 tag the 15-digit number will be confirmed with RFID reader.

Optional vaccination (BVD, PI3, BRSV, IBR) and deworming will be offered at Tag Day. \$2 for vaccination and \$3 for deworming.
