Section 2 - Rabbits

1. All rabbits are judged according to the latest standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
2. Breed rabbits must be over 4 lbs. or at least the ARBA weight standard. Rabbits will be weighed at entry.
3. Pet class entries consist of mixed breeds. Mixed breeds do not meet ARBA standards and are ineligible for breed classes.
4. No does with litters.
5. Sr. Buck, Jr. Buck, Sr. Doe and Jr. Doe are judged in each breed. Intermediate Buck and Doe will be judged in the Heavy Breeds. There will be Senior, Intermediate, and Junior classes in all breeds maturing 10 lbs. and over.
6. Exhibitors may enter up to two meat pens of rabbits. Meat pens consist of three rabbits of the same breed and variety and not over 10 weeks of age. Each rabbit in the pen must weigh between 3.5 lbs. and 5.5 lbs. at check-in.
7. **All rabbits must have a permanent tattoo in the left ear. Writing on the rabbit's ear with a pen or marker will not be accepted.** Breeding rabbits are welcomed to be tattooed at the **Rabbit Tattoo Day, held on July 11, 2026, 8 a.m.-12 p.m.** at the fairgrounds.
8. ****NEW**Meat Pens that are weighed in at the fair and do not make weight, may NOT be entered into a breed class and all three rabbits must return home.**
